2/3. New ESB Regulations / Enforcement issues

Ravi reviewed the new regulations affecting the Enforcement Team
Discussion was held on the practical impact of these regulations on the operation of the roadside inspections.

All parties agreed that when an FLC vehicle is pulled from the road the workers will be housed in that vehicle and will not be allowed to wander the inspection site. This is to avoid any danger of the workers walking onto highway. The FLC vehicle will not be towed until such time the workers are safely transported away from the inspection area.

If alternate transportation is required then the regulation will be enforced.

All parties agreed that significant vehicle orders issued by Worksafe or CVSE will be sent to Rod with a cover letter. These will be considered when applying the regulations affecting potential cancellation of ESB FLC licence.
