1. Roadside Enforcement Inspections
Inspections are on track as planned and scheduled.
2. Minivan Inspections
ESB indicated many Farm workers are being transported by Minivans. CVSE clarified their policy and the inspection of these vehicles is outside their mandate. Enforcement team discussed the issue and possible solutions. It was decided to send this issue to the bigger committee for a decision/direction. In the interim, to maintain affective inspection, the RCMP will pull minivans into the inspection areas and ask for inspection assistance from CVSE. This will satisfy mandates and not offend any policy. ESB can compile a list of FLC's that have registered minivans to clarify the scope of the issue.
3. WorkSafe wanted clarification of the start times for the inspections. After discussion it was decided that all inspections will have a standing start time of 5 am unless there is a **communicated** change in start time.
